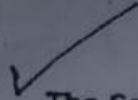

2. The Regulations Wing, S&GAD has examined the matter and views of Regulations Wing, S&GAD is given below in annotated form:

Point of advice	Views of Regulations Wing, S&GAD
Whether they may be considered on regular basis from the date of their appointment in the light of decision of Honorable High Court in Writ Petition No. 5484/2019 pronounced on 20.09.2019 or from the date of S&GAD circular letter dated 29.10.2019.	The laws, rules, policies, notifications, orders, circular letters issued by the Regulations Wing, S&GAD are <u>implemented from prospective effect until and unless specified otherwise.</u>
According to Contract Policy they have been received 30% Social Security Benefit in lieu of pension during the period of their contract.	As the 30% SSB was allowed to contract employees while, pension is admissible to the regular civil servants.
Furthermore, they are not deducting the Group Insurance, GP Fund and Benevolent Fund. What will be the fate of the Social Security Benefit, Group Insurance, GP Fund and benevolent Fund?	Since the regularization of the contract employees recruited under 17-A will be made with immediate effect, no question arises for deduction of Group Insurance, GP Fund and benevolent Fund. However, when the services of these are regularized, such deductions will be made as per prescribed procedure.
