Subject:- FIXATION OF PAY OF OFFICERS/OFFICIALS IN RECEIPT OF SPECIAL PAY ON THEIR PROMOTION TO HIGHER POST/GRADES.

Sir.

I am directed to state that a large number of cases are referred to this Department for relaxation of provisions of the Civil Services Rules as well as Pay Revision Rules so as to treat special pays being drawn by civil se wants at the time of promotion as part of the basic pay on the lower posts for the purpose of fixation of pay in pay scales of the higher posts. Acceptance of such proposals, with a view to avoiding hardship to the employees concerned due to loss in emoluments on promotion, has created certain a.o. alies because some junior civil servants have started getting higher gays on promotion than their seniors in the cadre who were not drawing special pay, or were drawing special pays at lower rates, immediately before prometion, Moreover, no uniform policy has been followed in dealing ith individual cases of this nature. In some cases, the civil servents were allowed the benefit of a premature increment on the total of pay and special pay drawn by them immediately before proportion; in others pay was fixed in pay scale of the higher post at the stage next above the total of pay and special pay of the employees on the lower post.

2. In order to avoid and alies of the nature mentioned above and to follow a uniform and equitable policy in this regard, it has been decided that, in accordance with the normal rules on the subject, special

pay will not in future be treated as part of the basic pay of a civil servant for the purpose of fixation of his pay on promotion from a lower to a higher post/grade. However, to save the employers concerned from loss in employers on premotion, it differences between the pay fixed on the higher post under the normal rules and total of pay and special pay drawn by a civil servant immediately before promotion will be allowed to him as personal pay to be absorbed in any folgon increase in pay due to increments or otherwise. Such personal pay my we allowed by the sudic without reference to this department.

3. The above instructions do not apply to the civil servants who at the time of promotion are drawing special pays which are in the nature of a substitute for a segarate pay scale and cannot be discontingent except on promotion or demotion of the civil servent concerned. Some examples of such special pays acrothe special may of Additional District and Sessions Judges which they draw in addition to the pay in Grade 18 admissible to the Sunfor Civil Judges, the special pay of Deputy Secretaring belonging to the Secretariat Group which is in addition to the pay in Grado 18 admissible to them as Under Sucretaries before promotion as Deputy Secretaries, the special pay of extra Assistant Directors of Agriculture which they draw is addition to the basic pay in Grade 17 admissible to them as Agriculture Officers infore exemption as Extra Assistant Pirectors of Agriculture. Such special pays are a part of the basic may of the civil servants concerned and should be treated as such for the purpose of fixation of their pay on promotion. Their cases will, however, he referred to the Finance Department for relax tion of the provisions of sule 4.4 of CSR(Punjab) Volume I.Part 1.
