Sub: - **ADVICE REGARDING INCREMENT IN SALARY**

I am directed to refer to your Memo No.UE/TR/2011/3616, dated 28.10.2011, on the subject noted above and to convey that the claim of Dr. Muhammad Mansha, Assistant Professor of Zoology (BS-19), University of Education, Lahore has been examined in the Finance Department and observed that his said claim is not maintainable on the following reasons:-

- i) Under Rule-7 of Pay Revision Rules, 1977, the annual increment is due on 1st day of December to a civil servant following the completion of at least six months service at a stage in the relevant National Pay Scales. Whereas, the officer had left the charge of the post of Lecturer (BS-17) prior to 1st December and had not completed the requisite length of service for award of annual increment due on 1st December 2010 in BS-19 (Copy enclosed).
- ii) No doubt, the officer served more than six months service against the post of Lecturer (BS-17) but when he left the charge of the post of Lecturer (BS-17) prior to 1st December and service in BS-19 was less than six months on 01.12.2010, he was not eligible for annual increment due on 01.12.2010.
- iii) As far as exercising of an option for re-fixation of pay with reference to notional pay in the lower scale on 01st December of that year as laid down in Para-10(3) of Pay Revision Rules, 1977 is concerned (Copy enclosed), it is not applicable in case of fresh appointment rather it is applicable in the cases of promotion only.
